INTRODUCTION

A Breast Reduction, also known as Reduction Mammoplasty, is a procedure that removes excess breast fat, glandular tissue & skin from overly large breasts.

The goal is to reduce the breast size in proportion to the client's body.

The procedure is reconstructive - while aesthetic changes will take place (i.e. to the size, shape and position of the breasts), surgeons are primarily concerned with alleviating client symptoms.

While significant, the benefits of Breast Reduction Surgery extend far beyond just alleviating physical discomfort of back, neck & shoulder pain



BENEFITS OF BREAST REDUCTION

Breast Reduction surgery is best suited to clients that have large, heavy, or asymmetrical breasts, and those who experience discomfort due to their size.

The procedure can:

- ☑ Ease physical pain
- ☑ Relieve skin irritation
- ☑ Improve social discomforts
- ☑ Aid in the ability to exercise

During your procedure, your skilled CosMediTour Plastic Surgeon reshapes & tightens the breast contour, resulting in:

- ☑ A firmer, more raised appearance
- ☑ A lift to the nipple position
- ☑ Reduced size of the areola (if enlarged over time)

YOUR SURGERY | 2 - 5 hours

Breast Reduction surgery takes 2 - 5 hours - depending on the amount of tissue to be removed. During this time, clients are placed under general anaesthesia.

WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOUR PROCEDURE

Recovery periods vary from person to person; however, we advise clients to allow 4 - 6 weeks for post-surgery recovery.



HOSPITAL STAY | Half Day - Overnight

In Australia, Breast Reductions are typically a day surgery. So, assuming good general health, clients can leave hospital 2 to 3 hours after they wake. Although rare, in some cases clients may need to stay overnight. Clients undergoing the procedure in Thailand are required to stay overnight. If opting for a combined procedure, all clients, regardless of where their procedure is conducted, may need to stay in hospital for 1 - 2 days.



REST TIME | 1 - 2 Weeks

Clients may experience slight discomfort, bruising, numbness & tightness across the chest. This is a normal part of the healing process & symptoms typically subside after 2 weeks. To aid recovery:

- ☒ Pain medication can be prescribed as needed.
- ☒ Clients can resume gentle walking & driving after 1 week.
- ☒ In most cases, normal activities including work, can resume 2 weeks after surgery.
- ☒ Avoid heavy lifting, strenuous exercise & swimming until your Surgeon advises.



RECOVERY TIME | 6 Weeks

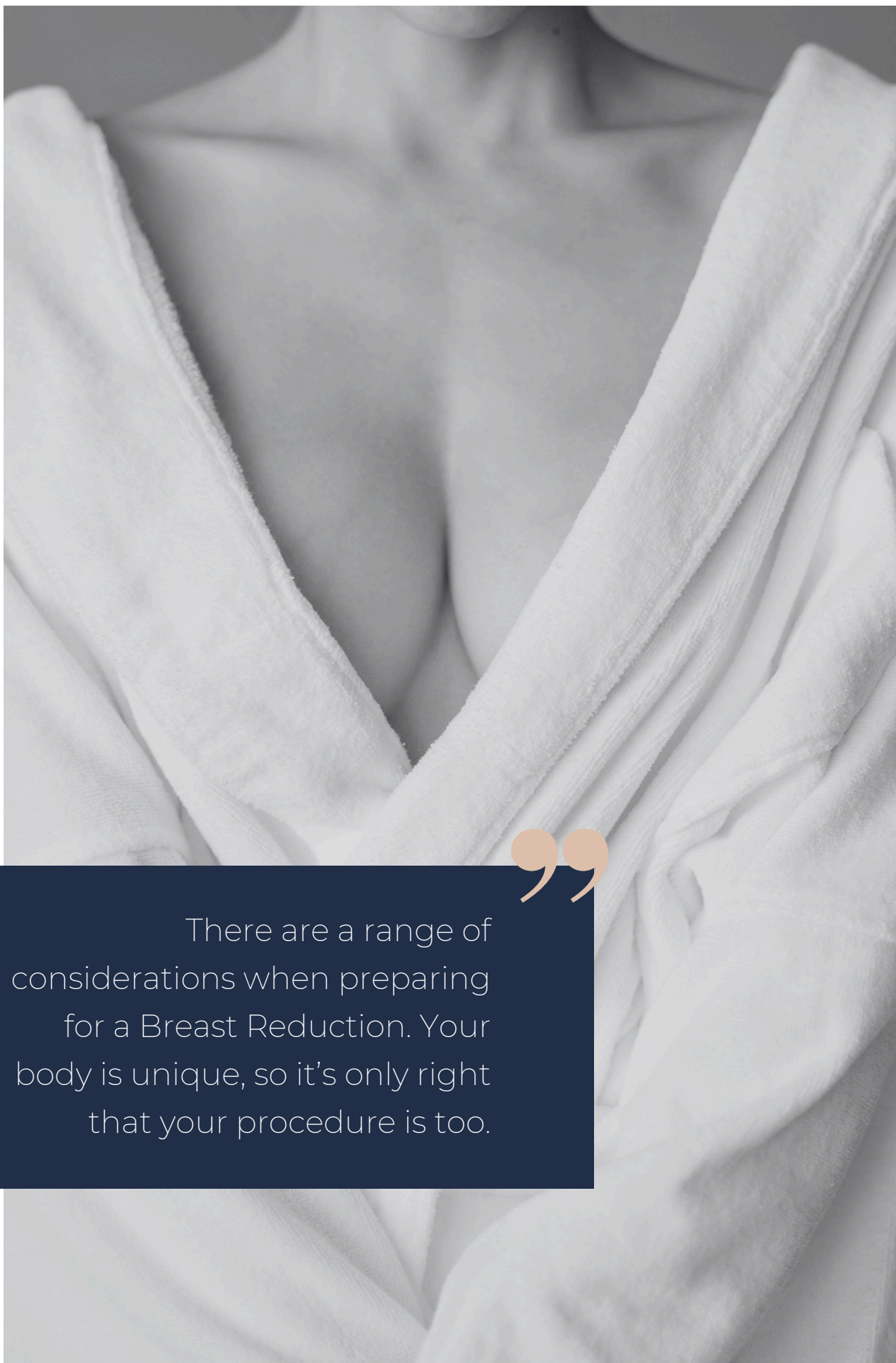
To ensure optimal healing, post-surgery support garments must be worn for 6 weeks.



SETTLING PERIOD | 6 - 12 Months

Breasts will become softer & more natural during this time. Scars may take up to 18 months to fade.

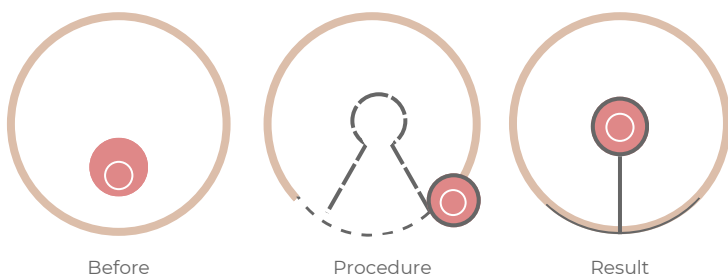
BREAST REDUCTION TECHNIQUE

ANCHOR TECHNIQUE

Also known as 'T-Lift Technique', this technique is used in Breast Reductions because it provides dramatic results & is suited to clients with:

- ✓ Large breasts
- ✓ Sagging (Ptosis)
- ✓ A large amount of fat, tissue & skin to be removed
- ✓ Asymmetrical breasts

The Anchor Technique involves a peri-areolar incision around the areola, a vertical incision from the base of the areola to the crease of the breast, and another along the breast crease (shown below).



A Breast Reduction may not be all that is required to restore the breasts to their natural, perky state. Your Surgeon may also suggest a Breast Lift to prevent the breasts from looking deflated or saggy.

POTENTIAL RISKS TO CONSIDER

While you can rest assured that you'll be in the most capable surgical hands throughout your CosMediTour Breast Reduction, there are potential risks to consider with all forms of surgery.

Our expert Plastic Surgeons take the utmost care to minimise the occurrence of surgical complications & work out of hospitals renowned for their high quality & practice standards. Most of the following possible risks & complications are ones associated with all surgeries.

RISKS & POSSIBLE COMPLICATIONS

- Surgical risks (infections, bleeding, clots, allergic reactions to medical materials)
- Seroma (fluid accumulation) around the incision site/inside the breast
- Haematoma (collection of blood) inside the breast
- Keloid or hypertrophic scarring (can be lumpy, inflamed, and itchy)
- Skin discolouration/permanent pigmentation changes
- Damage to nerves, blood vessels, muscles, and lungs (temporary or permanent)
- Fat necrosis resulting in hard lumps in skin
- Changes in breast & nipple sensation
- Breast asymmetry
- Stiff shoulder
- Need for further surgery to treat complications
