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BREAST SURGERY PROCEDURES

To achieve the best possible outcomes for you, your CosMediTour Surgeon may incorporate a combination of Breast Procedures in your treatment plan.

BREAST AUGMENTATION

Also known as an Augmentation Mammoplasty, or a Boob Job, this procedure involves the insertion of implants beneath the breast tissue to:

- ☑ Enhance breast size
- ☑ Enhance breast shape



BREAST LIFT

A Breast Lift, or Mastopexy, involves the removal of excess skin to remedy Ptosis (sagging).

- ☑ Restores natural 'perkiness'
- ☑ Reshapes breast contour



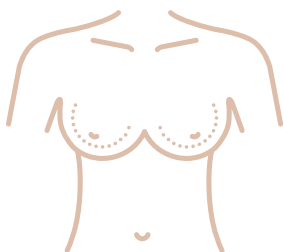
The first & most obvious consideration when preparing for breast surgery is the combination of procedures required.



BREAST REDUCTION

Also known as a Reduction Mammoplasty, this procedure involves the removal of excess fat, skin & glandular tissue. This is done to:

- ☑ Reduce the breasts in proportion to the client's body.



BREAST EXPLANT

Also known as Breast Revision Surgery or Augmentation Reversal, this is typically performed because of preference changes, implant complications or implant-related illnesses. This can be done to:

- ☑ Remove the implants
- ☑ Reposition existing implants
- ☑ Replace the implants with new ones.

YOUR SURGERY | From 2 hours

Breast Surgery takes anywhere from 2 hours - depending on additional procedures. A Breast Augmentation, on its own, takes between 1 to 2 hours. When a Breast Lift or Reduction is added, this increases to 3 hours. Breast Explants can be slightly more complicated & when combined with a Breast Lift, take up to 5 hours. All Breast Surgeries are performed under general anaesthesia.

WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOUR PROCEDURE

Recovery periods vary from person to person and the procedure/s undertaken.



HOSPITAL STAY | 1 - 2 nights

The length of time in hospital is dependent on:

- ✓ The complexity of the surgery & number of procedures undertaken.
- ✓ Your post-surgery health.
- ✓ Whether the client has someone to monitor their recovery at home.
- ✓ Where your procedure is conducted. Many Breast Procedures in Australia are considered Day Surgery, so clients may be able to leave hospital 2 - 3 hours after they wake. Clients undergoing Breast Procedures in Thailand are required to stay overnight at a minimum.



REST TIME | 3 Weeks

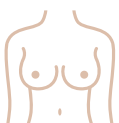
Swelling, bruising & tightness across the chest is common in the first few days. To aid recovery:

- ✓ Use ice packs & pain medication to manage pain.
- ✓ No driving, work or exercise in the 1st week.
- ✓ In the 2nd or 3rd week, clients can ease into light, lower body exercise & in most cases, return to work.
- ✓ Avoid heavy lifting, strenuous exercise & swimming until your Surgeon advises.



RECOVERY TIME | 6 Weeks

To ensure optimal healing & reduce swelling, post-surgery support garments must be worn for 6 weeks.



SETTLING PERIOD | 6 - 12 Months

A full recovery will take place over 6 to 12 months. During this time, the implants (if applicable) will settle to their final position & the breasts will become softer. Scars can take up to 18 months to fade.

- ☑ Implant Choice & Placement
- ☑ Incision Placement
(for Breast Augmentation & Explant)
- ☑ Surgical Techniques
(for Breast Lift & Reduction)

DECISIONS TO MAKE WITH YOUR SURGEON

IMPLANT CHOICE

BREAST AUGMENTATION & EXPLANT

Implant choice is key in planning the perfect Breast Augmentation. Similarly, when planning a Breast Explant, implants must be considered. They can be removed completely, repositioned, or replaced with new implants.

To select the ideal implant, surgeons are very careful to consider the client's natural breast tissue & anatomy, as well as being mindful of correct form and symmetry.

All Breast Implants used by CosMediTour Surgeons are Cohesive Silicone Gel, otherwise referred to as 'gummy bear texture'. Cohesive Silicone Gel Implants are believed by many to feel more like real breasts than their Saline counterparts.

IMPLANT SIZE

Your Surgeon will be able to advise you on what will work best for your body, not just now, but in the future, when determining implant size.

PROJECTION

A breast implant's projection is how far forward it extends in front of your chest. The cup size increases as the profile increases.

IMPLANT TYPE

The surface of Breast Implants are either Smooth, or a Micro or Nano Textured. The surfaces of smooth implants are softer, while the textured surfaces reduce movement risks.

IMPLANT SHAPE

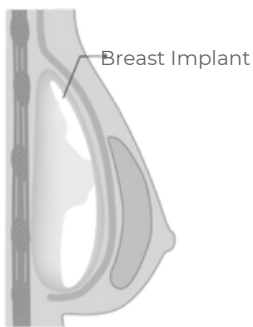
Teardrop implants, also known as anatomical implants, are designed to mimic the natural shape of the breast with more fullness in the lower part & less fullness at the top.

Round implants are circular & symmetrical in shape. They provide more fullness & volume to the upper part of the breast, creating a more dramatic effect.

IMPLANT PLACEMENT

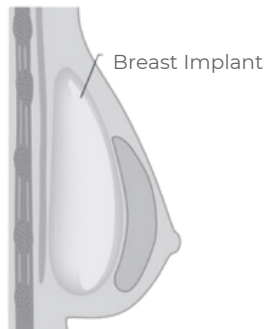
BREAST AUGMENTATION & EXPLANT

Breast implant placement is determined by numerous factors, including a client's skin, body composition, existing breast tissue, lifestyle & desired result. There are three implant placement approaches your Surgeon may take.



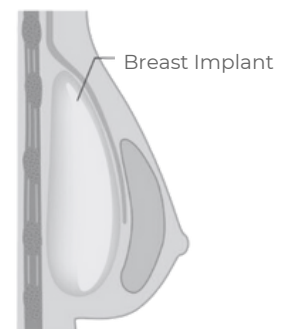
UNDER MUSCLE

The implant sits under the pectoralis major muscle (the pec). This allows for layered cover over the implant, with soft tissue smoothing ridges that may otherwise form between the implant & skin.



OVER MUSCLE

The implants sits between the pec & the breast tissue. This allows the implant to push the breast into a more regular shape & is generally suited to clients with a good volume of natural breast tissue.



DUAL PLANE

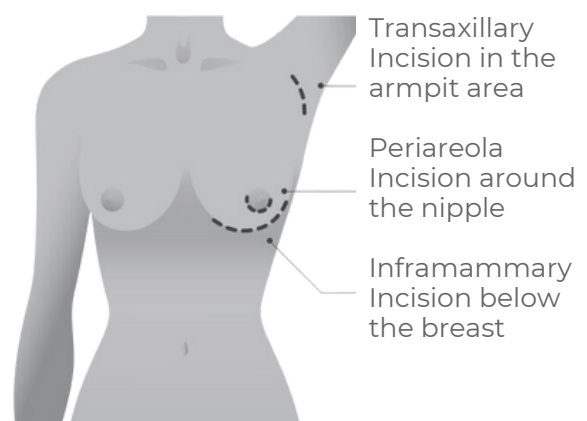
This combines the Over & Under Muscle placements. The upper half of the implant is placed under the pec, while the lower half sits above it (under the breast tissue).

INCISION PLACEMENT

BREAST AUGMENTATION & EXPLANT

There are 3 incision placements typically used in Breast Augmentation & Explants.

Inframammary and trans-axillary are the most used incisions as they cause minimal scarring. They also work best with common Lift and Reduction techniques, thus reducing the total number of incisions required for combined procedures.



TECHNIQUES

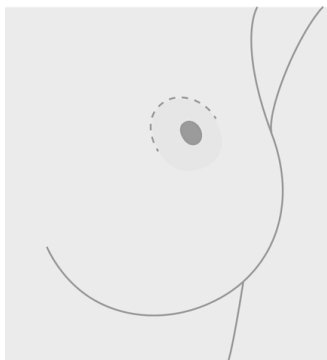
BREAST LIFT & BREAST REDUCTION

There are a number of Breast Lift & Breast Reduction techniques available to surgeons - each are named after the incision/s used. Each of the techniques have their benefits and result in varying degrees of lift, ranging from slight to more dramatic results.

The technique your Plastic Surgeon uses for your procedure will be dictated by your personal Ptosis & what, if any, other breast enhancement procedures you are having.

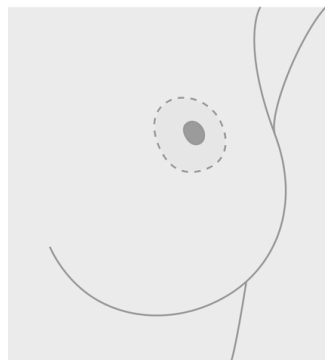
CRESCENT TECHNIQUE

- ✓ Suited to clients with minor to moderate sagging and/or small breasts.
- ✓ Provides a small degree of lift & can correct nipple asymmetry.
- ✓ Involves a half-moon shaped incision above the areola. A small amount of breast tissue is removed before the bottom of the incision is lifted to join the top.



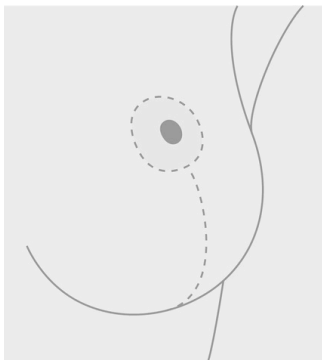
PERI-AREOLAR TECHNIQUE

- ✓ Also known as the Donut Technique
- ✓ Suited to clients with minor to moderate sagging and/or tuberous breasts.
- ✓ Provides a small degree of lift; however, it can also be used to reduce areola size.
- ✓ Involves a circular incision around the areola.



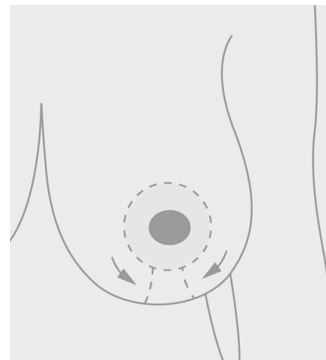
VERTICAL TECHNIQUE

- ✓ Also known as the Lollipop Technique
- ✓ Suited to clients with moderate sagging & larger breasts.
- ✓ Provides a large degree of lift & projection. Can also reduce the size of the areola, elevate the nipples & result in less noticeable scarring.
- ✓ Involves 2 incisions - one around the areola & the other from the areola down to the natural crease of the breast.



ANCHOR (T-LIFT) TECHNIQUE

- ✓ Also known as T-Lift Technique
- ✓ Suited to clients with large breasts & severe sagging. Commonly used for clients also having a Breast Reduction.
- ✓ Provides dramatic results
- ✓ Involves 3 incisions: a peri-areolar incision around the areola, a vertical incision from the base of the areola to the crease of the breast, and a concave incision along the crease of the breast



LIPOSUCTION

BREAST REDUCTION

If undergoing a Breast Reduction procedure, your surgeon might recommend Liposuction as part of your Treatment Plan. This procedure removes a large volume of tissue & results in a significantly lighter feeling breast.

Performed in isolation, Liposuction will cause the breasts to look deflated or saggy. For this reason, it is typically, combined with Breast Lift and/or Reduction procedure.

POTENTIAL RISKS TO CONSIDER

While you can rest assured that you'll be in the most capable surgical hands throughout your CosMediTour Breast Surgery, there are potential risks to consider with all forms of surgery.

Our expert Plastic Surgeons take the utmost care to minimise the occurrence of surgical complications & work out of hospitals renowned for their high quality & practice standards. Most of the following possible risks & complications are ones associated with all surgeries.

RISKS & POSSIBLE COMPLICATIONS

- Surgical risks (infections, bleeding, allergic reactions to medical materials)
- Seroma (fluid accumulation) around the implant/incision site
- Haematoma (collection of blood) inside the breast
- Changes in nipple and breast sensitivity
- Numbness around incision scars (temporary or permanent)
- Keloid or hypertrophic scarring (can be lumpy, inflamed, and itchy)
- Wrinkling of the skin over the implant
- Implant rupture, slippage, or movement
- Lumps in lymph node tissue (caused by leaking silicone – not a health risk)
- Swelling and bruising
- Stiff Shoulder
- Breastfeeding difficulties
- Skin discolouration/permanent pigmentation changes
- Fat necrosis resulting in hard lumps in skin
- Capsular contracture refers to when scar tissue forms around the implant. It is generally a normal part of the healing process (& can actually prevent slippage), however occasionally it can interfere with the shape & feel of the breast. In rare cases, capsular contracture can be painful & caused by ruptured implants.
- Asymmetry (uneven breasts)
- Breast deformity or ptosis (sagging) after Explant
- Potential/partial loss of nipple and areola
- Damage to nerves, blood vessels, muscles, and lungs (temporary or permanent)
- Reduced effectiveness of breast screening (modern imaging has made this less of a concern)
- Need for further surgery to treat complications
